YEAR 4 BIKE EDUCATION AND SAFETY TRAINING

Redcliffe Police-Citizens Youth Club is offering a Bicycle Education & Safety Training (BEST) day for our Year Four students during Week Two, Term Two. BEST is run by an experienced Police Officer and trained bicycle instructors. It is designed to be challenging, educational, rewarding and fun. The cost is \$5 per student. Payment is due by tomorrow 19 April.

Students of BEST learn:

1. Knowledge and understanding of the road traffic environment & road rules
2. Physical & cognitive skills to control the bicycle and manage the traffic environment
3. Responsible behaviours, attitudes and decision-making skills for safe use of bicycles on and off the road
